CC/CC Questions can be used with any Fiction text -- and *many Non-Fiction* texts, as well -- to help

- ~ Promote **empathy and compassion**
- ~ Increase students' ability to **perceive the feelings** of others, and **identify their own feelings**
- ~ Develop students' ability to perceive and understand **unmet needs** (of others, and their own)
 - ~ Promote **Restorative Practices and Justice**
- ~ Develop students' ability to use a **Trauma-Informed / Responsive Lens**

Any / all of the questions below can be repeatedly asked,
and can be answered 1-on-1, in a **Community Building Circle**, and/or in writing:

Q 1: How did the character/s feel, and why?
Q 2: What was the harm/ trauma caused? Who was hurt, and how?
Q 3: What did anyone do to demonstrate Compassion or employ Restorative Justice?
Q 4: What would you do to demonstrate Compassion or employ Restorative Justice?
Q 5: What were the character's unmet needs?

Compassionate Comprehension can help meet **academic goals**

~ by asking "What is your evidence or proof from the text?"

~ by offering opportunities for students to explore the questions orally, in writing, and/or using Visual/ Performing Arts

☛ These 5 Questions can provide **Community-Building Circle** topics and/or **writing** prompts:

Think of a time when you experienced the same feelings and/or the same unmet needs. Please share.

Resources

* **The Peace Path** can help promote empathy and compassion and also help resolve conflicts. Use of the Peace Path can help strengthen students' awareness of and ability to deal with the concepts included in the five questions above:

- ~ Feelings, and empathy and compassion for others' feelings
- ~ Harm / trauma, and empathy and compassion for others' harm / trauma
- ~ The ways in which Restorative Justice employs empathy and compassion
- ~ Unmet needs, and empathy and compassion for others' unmet needs
